Materials Needed: popsicle sticks, labels, florists foam, colored toothpicks

Directions:

1. Listen to background information about what landscape architecture is. As a group, brainstorm where landscape architecture is typically found
2. Survey the school grounds and evaluate our current landscape. What is the situation? Are there any issues? What are ways to improve our landscape architecture?
3. Brainstorm important features for the landscape of a school.
4. Create a 3D model of the “ideal” landscape for the group. The model will be made out of florist’s foam, colored toothpicks, popsicle sticks for trees. You must incorporate a playground, parking, etc. Label your key features.
5. Choose and make the representative elements to place into your portfolio.
